Teaching obligations cover microbial ecology and microbial plant interactions.

Active participation in research consortia such as the Collaborative Research Centre (CRC) 766 "The Bacterial Envelope", the Research Training Group (RTG) 1708 "Bacterial Survival Strategies", the "German Centre for Infection Research" (DZIF) or the CRC 1101 "Molecular Coding of Specificity in Plant Processes" and in other sought consortia is expected.

A formal requirement for appointment is the "Habilitation" or equivalent scientific and educational experience.

The University of Tübingen is committed to strengthen the proportion of women in research and teaching, and strongly encourages applications of qualified female scientists.

Applicants with disabilities who possess equivalent qualifications will be given preferential treatment.
