



The Faculty of Agriculture at the University of Bonn invites applications for a

Full Professorship (W3) in "Plant Pathology"

to be appointed on a permanent basis at the earliest possible date.

We are seeking to appoint an internationally renowned leader with an established scientific, forward-looking profile in the field of plant-pathogen interactions. Research approaches should be mechanistic and preferentially targeted to systems and topics with agricultural relevance (e.g. early detection of plant diseases and their control, resistance mechanisms of plants against pathogens, or antagonists against plant pathogens). We expect a convincing link to locally established topics, such as those of the excellence initiative "PhenoRob". Success in acquisition of third-party funding, and strong accomplishments within the respective projects is a precondition. The holder of the position is expected to teach Phytopathology at undergraduate and graduate levels.

The conditions of employment are according to § 36 Hochschulgesetz NRW.

The University of Bonn is committed to diversity and equal opportunity. It is certified as a family-friendly university and has a dual career program.
