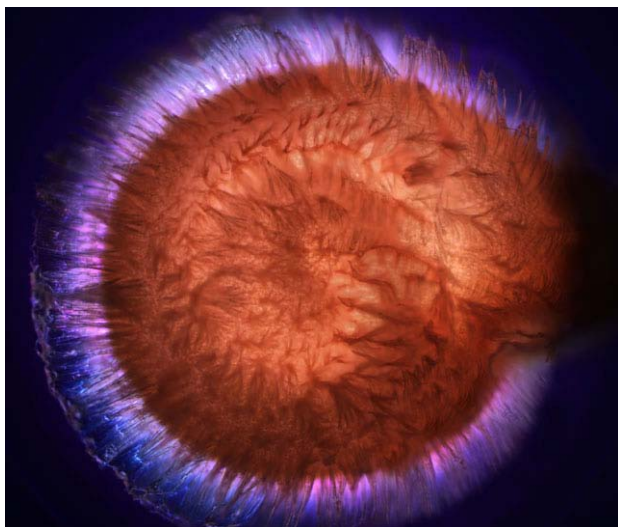


INTERNATIONAL SCIENCE & ENGINEERING VISUALIZATION CHALLENGE

NSF and the journal Science created the International Science & Engineering Visualization (“SciVis”) Challenge to celebrate and encourage the visual communication of science for education and journalistic purposes. The 2011 contest is now accepting entries, and for the first time in the history of the competition, participants can submit entries online. Judges appointed by NSF and Science will select winners in each of five categories: photography, illustrations, informational posters and graphics, interactive games, and videos. The winning entries will appear in a special section in both the print edition of Science and on the Science and NSF websites.
