

Goal of the field seminar


- Visits of industrial and mining areas, research facilities and many related sites with special importance for / to applied geosciences
- We will visit several sites in Middle / Central
 Germany which were heavily disturbed by industrial
 use over the last century, e.g.:
 - former and active mining for lignite (coal)
 - o former mining for copper, uranium and salt
 - heavy industrial use (e.g. Bitterfeld one corner of the "Middle German Chemical Triangle").

- 1 Lignite mining area
 Surface water quality, acid
 mine drainage, recultivated
 lignite mine, flood protection
- 2 Mansfeld area groundwater management; flood protection, gas reservoirs, problems due to salt and cooper mining
- 3 Chemical park Bitterfeld one of the oldest chemical parks in Germany with heavy contamination and one of the oldest lignite mines
- 4 Ore mountains (Erzgebirge) Former uranium mining area


